**Grade 6/5A – as per PCV rules, riders in PC section must be graded accordingly and be of age 8-10years. There is no age restriction on open section however the OC expects that only true beginners would enter this section.

NOTE: To enter BOTH HT and CT, combinations MUST be graded the same grade for both disciplines.

Conditions of Entry:

1. **Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that current PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.**
2. **OPEN RIDERS:**
 - a. Everyone needs to complete a Liability Declaration Form.
 - b. Participants need to pay \$10 Day Attendance Fee UNLESS they can provide proof which must be inspected at the secretary's office on the day that they are current financial members of:
 - Pony Club Association of Victoria;
 - Equestrian Australia* (EA);
 - HRCVA
 - an Inter State Pony Club;
 - Arab Horse Society of Australia (AHSA);
 - Australian Endurance Riders Association (AERA); or
 - can provide proof that they are covered by Public Liability Insurance Policy with a minimum of \$10,000,000.00
 - c. Riders without adequate Insurance Cover pay \$10 for Liability Only cover for the duration of the event. (Not personal Medical) and complete the Day Participant Waiver
 - d. PCV club member cards must be inspected at the secretary's office
 - e. PCV Insurance Policy specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.
3. **PCV club member cards** must be handed in at the secretary's office before riding.
4. **GEAR CHECK** before riding in each test/phase of the competition is required. PCV gear rules Jan 2017.
5. **HELMETS:** Complying helmets must be worn
 - ASSA3838 standard
 - EN1384 standard, made in 2015 or older
 - EN1384 standard plus the VG1 standard
 - VG1 standard
 - ASTHF1163 standard
6. All **refunds** will incur a \$15 administration fee. There shall be no refunds after 16th of July unless kslade@eventsecretary.com.au notified prior to ride time and a valid veterinary or doctor's medical certificate is provided within 7 days of notification.
7. The organising committee reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
8. Competitors may ride more than one horse, subject to the conditions of 2017 PCV *Handbook of By-laws* multiple horse rules.
9. **Medical Armbands:** must be worn by all competitors.
10. Queries, protests, horse abuse, rules as per the current PCV *Handbook of By-Laws*.
11. Dogs are prohibited without exception.
12. PCV Alcohol Policy applies. PCV Smoking policy applies.
13. Neither the organising committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
14. Presentations: will occur after scores have been posted for 30 minutes. Scoring equals separated as per PCV Handbook of bylaws Jan 2017.
15. Horses must be at least age four, no stallions, colts or rigs.
16. **Competitor numbers** - the organising committee will pre-allocate and advise numbers. Small body numbers will be available at the event; however it is advisable competitors provide their own. Competitors may supply their own bridle numbers displayed on both the left and right side of the bridle or saddlecloth numbers displayed on both the left and right side of the saddlecloth. However, body numbers must be used for cross-country.

17. Lunging at this competition must take place in the confined area designated exclusively for lunging, by the organizing committee. At a competition, only the competitor may ride or lunge his horse or pony. The penalty for disobeying this rule is elimination.
18. PCV Riders to be in full Pony Club uniform. Non-PCV riders similar.
19. **Best dressage** – riders must complete all phases to be eligible
20. **Closure of XC course** – The cross country course shall be closed from 8th July 2017. Any persons or horses using the cross country course after this date will be ineligible to complete.
